Materials


- Printed Carnivore or Herbivore
- Printed food
- Clothespin with spring
- Glue or tape
- Toothpick or other small stick
- Crayons or colored pencils

Instructions

- Print your Carnivore or Herbivore and its food and then cut them out. If you do not have a printer you can draw your own dinosaur and food.
- Color your dinosaur and food.
- Glue top of head to top part of clothespin and glue bottom head and body to the bottom clothespin. Let dry.
- Glue food to the end of the toothpick. Let dry.








