Hatching Turtle

Turtles, like most reptiles, hatch from eggs. With this craft, you can hatch your own turtle!

Know before you begin

- · This activity can be done inside or outside
- · All supplies are easy to find, substitute or modify
- · Adult supervision is recommended
- · Please choose a safe space for this activity

Materials

- Printer (If printing)
- Paper
- Crayons or markers
- Scissors (to be used under adult supervision)
- Hole punch (optional)
- · A paper fastener, paper clip or a small piece of string or yarn

Instructions

- · Print, trace or sketch the two images below.
- Color the turtle and eggshell with crayons or markers.
- Cut out the turtle and eggshell along their lines.
- Poke or punch out the marked holes.
- Arrange the three pieces so that the holes line up, with the two egg halves on top of the turtle.
- Fasten all three parts together with a fastener, clip or string.
- · Enjoy your new hatching turtle!
