Join us for Bug Fest, August 11–12. You'll learn about insects from our scientists, and see specimens from the Academy's collections.

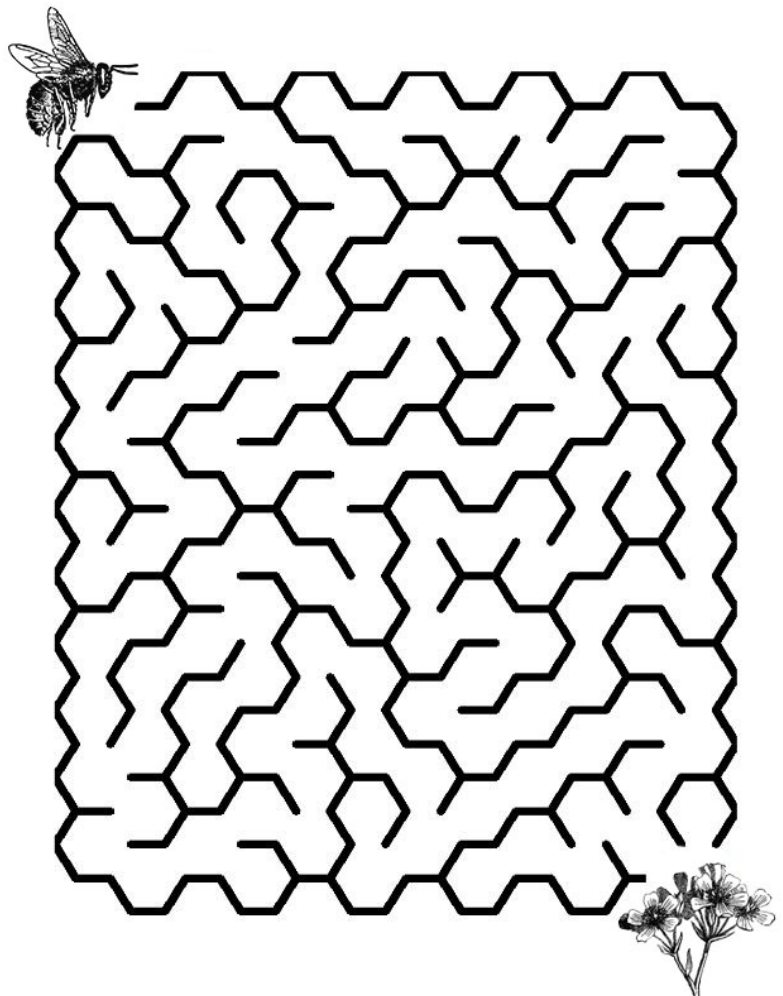
IT'S MEANT TO BEE

If you love bees, join us for Scientist Saturday on August 18 to meet entomologist Meghan Barrett. She studies some of the 4,000 species of native bees that live in the United States.

Three fast facts:

1. All worker bees are females. If you see a bee collecting nectar or pollen, she's a female bee.
2. Bees can fly more than 15 miles per hour. Their wings beat about 200 times per second!
3. During busy summer months, the queen bee can lay up to 2,500 eggs in one day.





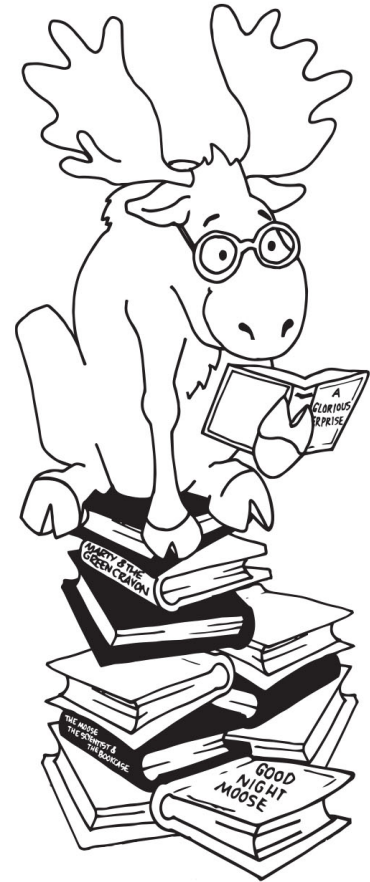
Don't forget your stamp.
