ACTIVITY #2

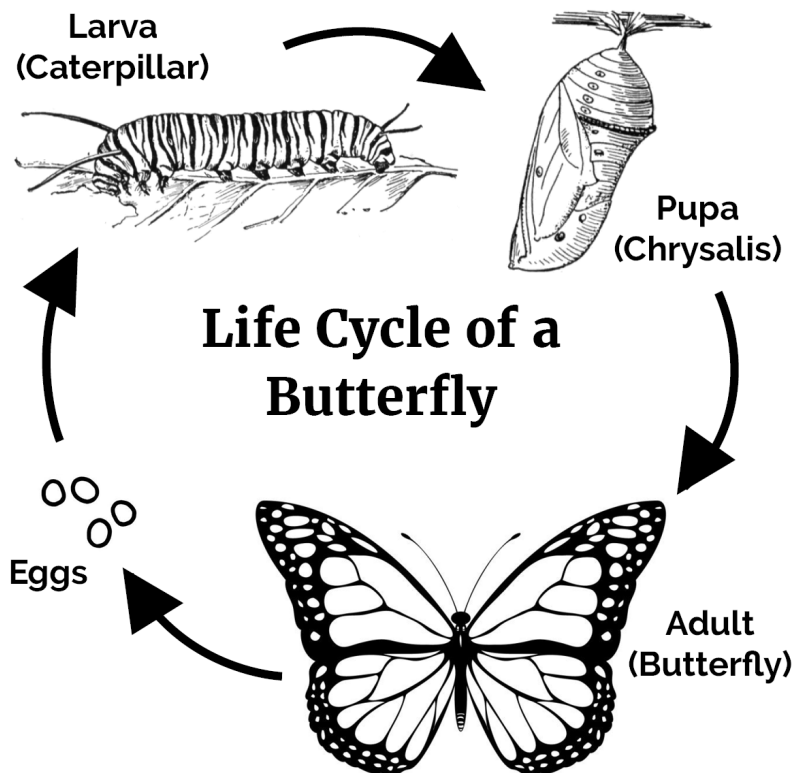
Join Marty the Moose for story time on Mondays at 1 p.m. in the auditorium. Or visit *Outside In* to read a science-themed book with your favorite adult.

Why are caterpillars so hungry?

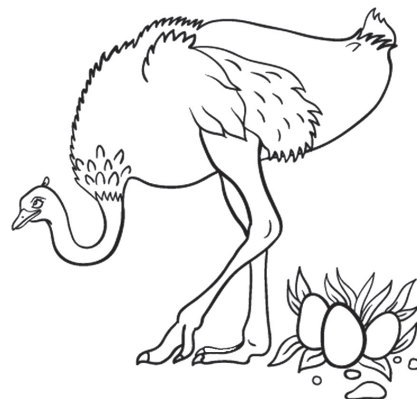


Don't forget your stamp.
