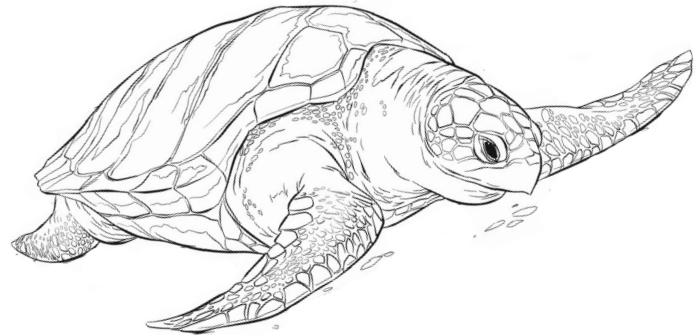
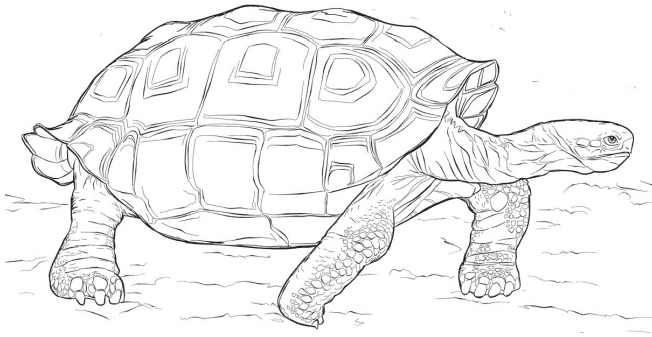


Don't forget your stamp.
