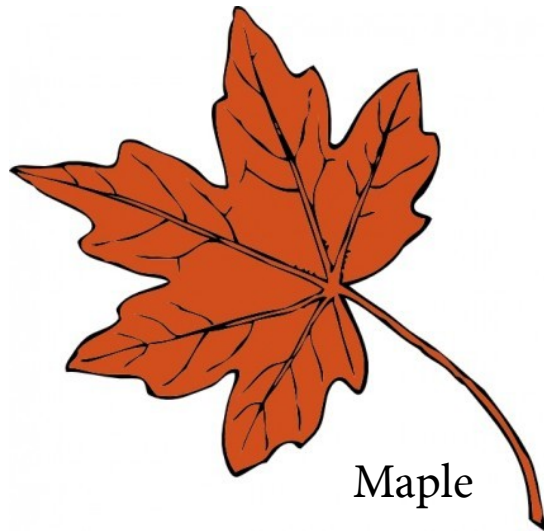

Take a nature walk around the Academy!

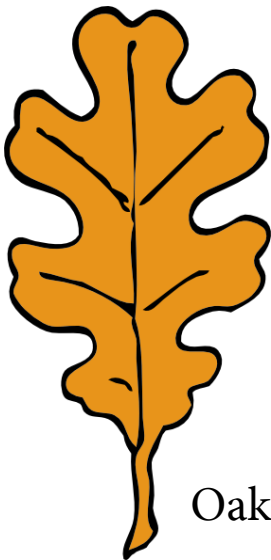
