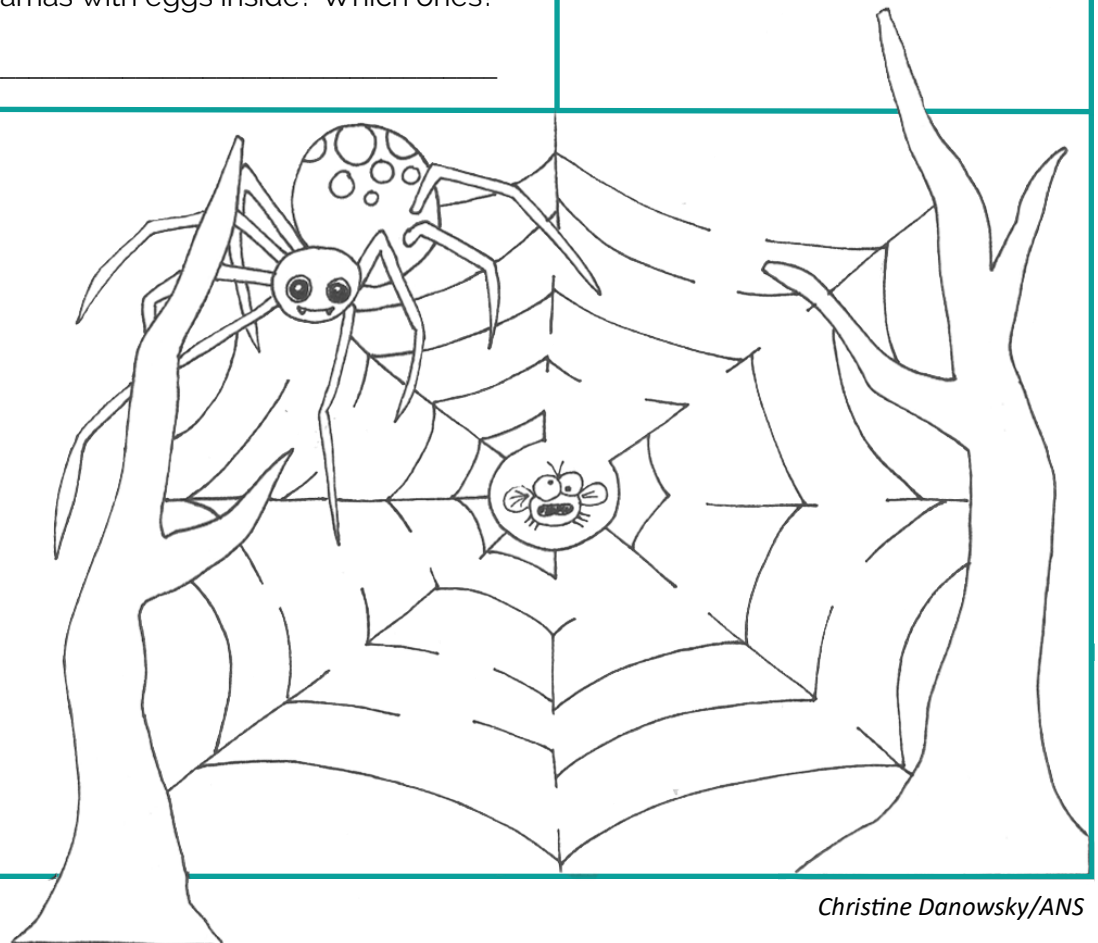

Oh no! The bee is caught in the spider's web! Help her avoid the traps and escape to safety.



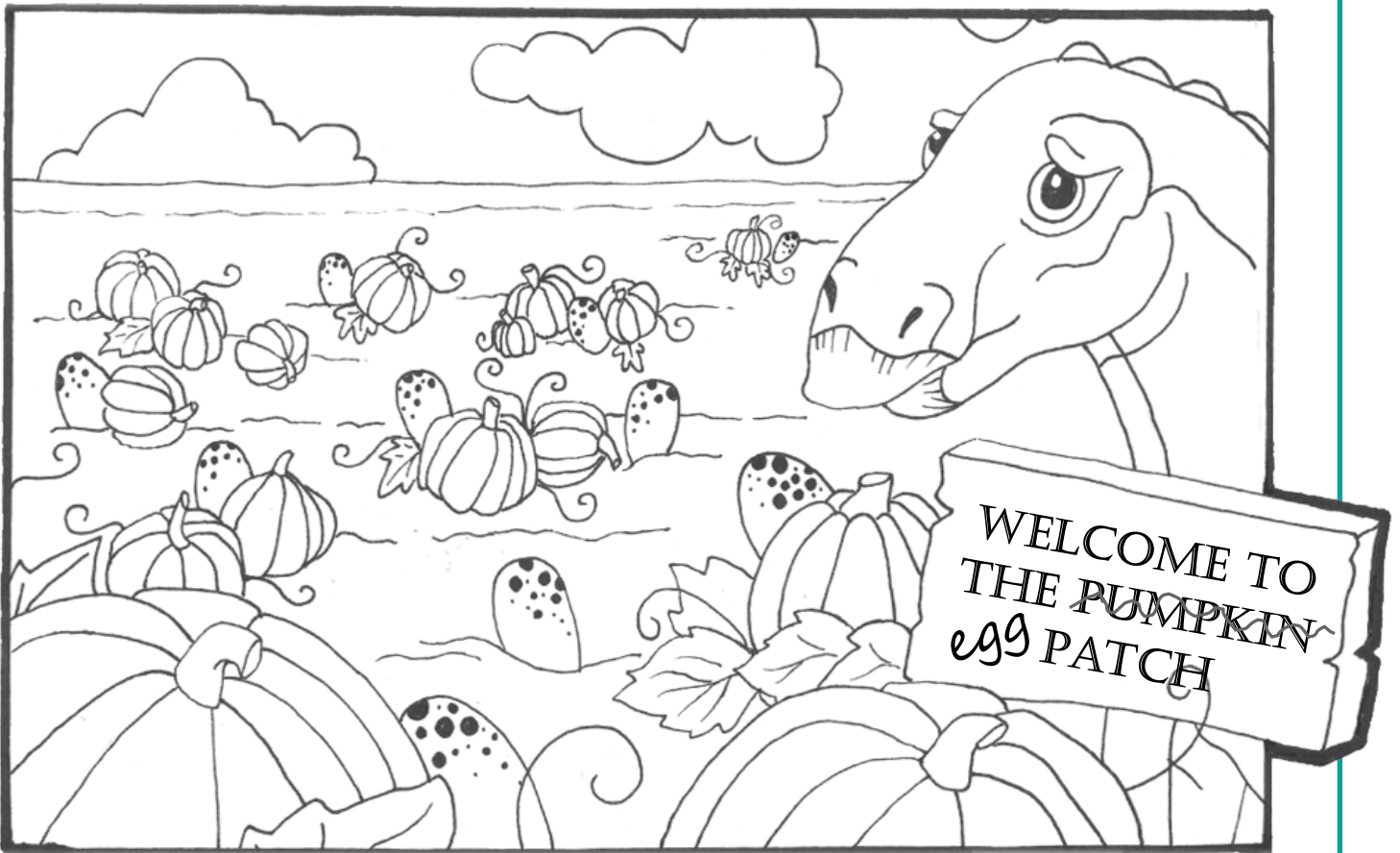
