# Camouflage Craft

Animals use camouflage to hide from potential predators, appear bigger, and hide from potential prey. Camouflage is not just about appearance; camouflage can also include behaviors that mimic something to avoid predators or prey. Can you make an animal that camouflages into the background?

- Leaves
- Orange paint
- Twigs
- Green paint
- Grasses
- Gray paint
- White cardstock
- Light brown paintDark brown paint
- Animal cutouts: turtle, lizard, snake


### Instructions

- 1. Use a sheet of cardstock to design a habitat.
- 2. Create camouflage background using leaves, sticks, twigs and paint.
- 3. Choose an animal to camouflage.
- 4. Paint animal to camouflage to background.
