Toilet Paper Tube Sharks

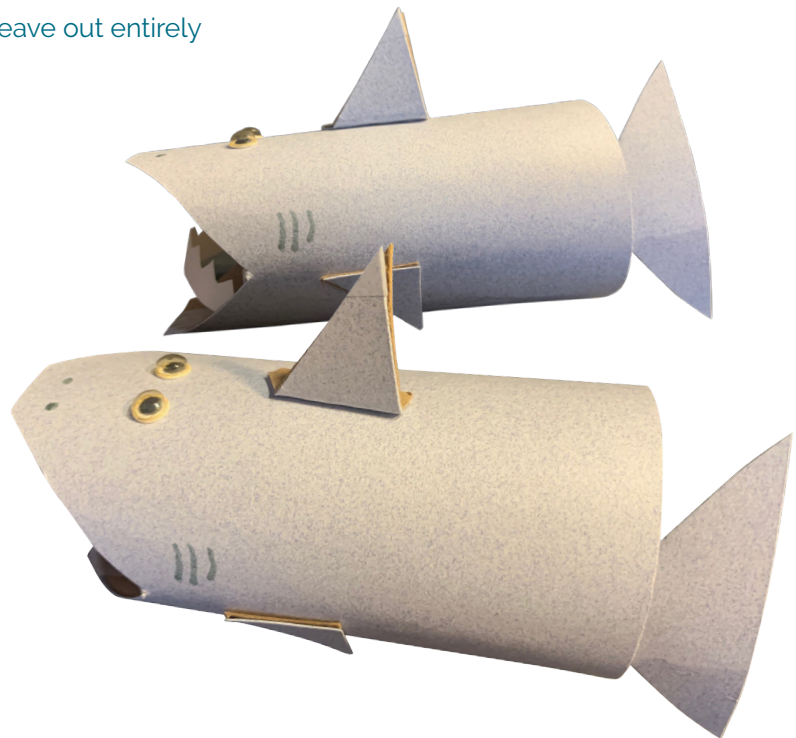
Sharks are one of the few groups of animals that has been around since the time of the dinosaurs. These amazing creatures have changed little in all that time. Construct your favorite shark out of a toilet paper tube.

Know before you begin

- This activity can be done inside or outside
- All supplies are easy to find, substitute or leave out entirely
- Adult supervision is recommended
- Please choose a safe space to play

Materials

- Toilet paper tube
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Paint
- Markers
- Glue
- White scrap paper





Instructions

1. Paint the toilet paper tube and let it dry.
2. Cut out teeth from scrap paper. It's best if the teeth are one solid piece, like this:



3. Once the toilet paper tube is dry, cut triangles out of the sides of the front to create a mouth. Save the pieces you cut out because one will be the tail, and the other will be the fin.
4. Glue eyes, tail and fin to shark.
5. Use markers to add gills.
